Prizes and Trophies

The 2026 Kiama Sevens is once again held at the beautiful Kiama Showgrounds, alongside Kiama Surf Beach and just a short stroll to the famous Kiama Blowhole. Games commence at 8:00 am.



Naming sponsors

The Kiama Sevens Cup is presented to the Champion Club. There will be prizes for the teams reaching the semi-finals and finals (starting at approximately 4.15pm).

In 2026 prize money including trophies is valued at over \$35,000.

The prizemonies include \$6,000 for the champion club and \$3,500 for the runner-up in the Cup competition. There is a Plate competition with \$3,000 for the winner and \$2,000 for runner-up - plus, a Bowl competition with \$2,000 for the winner and \$1,000 for runner-up.

This is our 17th year for the Mens Country Cup with \$2,000 for winner and \$1,000 for runner-up.

The Womens competition takes the form of a 12 team competition and will follow the same laws as the Men's competition.

The Competition Organisation Committee will adjudicate all disputes and the Committee's decision is final.

The Kiama Sevens is an ARU club competition and takes the form of a 44 team sevens round robin competition. Each club can enter two teams but if nominations are in excess of 44 your club may be restricted back to 1 team. Clubs will nominate for a division and placed in groups and elimination rounds played. Every team is guaranteed 3 games. The best performed teams from each group will play other group winners in that division for the trophies.



History of the Kiama Sevens


The Kiama Rugby Football Club was established in 1893 and in 1997 erected its own clubhouse overlooking Kiama Showground, Kiama Blowhole and ocean.

The Kiama Sevens Tournament had its humble beginnings in 1973 with eight teams participating in a competitive, yet social event. As the Kiama Sevens celebrates its 54th year, we are recognised as the largest one day Sevens tournament in Australia. In 2015 we introduced a major realignment to give the optimum

pathway to the Olympics - a dramatic change with the welcome support of the Australian Rugby Union.

The Kiama Sevens plays host to 32 mens and 12 womens sides, consisting of five hundred players and attracting Sydney 1st Division teams, Sydney Subdistricts, NSW Country, ACT Rugby Union, Victorian and QLD Sides.

The Tournament is attended by over 5,000 spectators and receives wide media coverage on television, radio and newspapers.
